- The EU-ALMPO project builds on past efforts and research aimed at improving **Active Labor Market Policies** (ALMPs) across Europe.
- Policymakers have long faced **challenges** in designing **ALMPs** that are:
 - Well-informed and **evidence-based**,
 - Effectively **targeted**, and
 - Responsive to evolving labor market needs.



The Case for an ALMP Observatory



The Current Challenge



- **Fragmented Data:** Labor market information is scattered and unstructured.
- **Reactive Policy:** Interventions often lag behind rapid market transformations.
- **Static Studies:** Reliance on outdated evaluations rather than real-time evidence.

The EU-ALMPO Vision



- **Centralized Intelligence:** A single EU hub for ALMP data.
- **AI-Driven Monitoring:** Moving from static reports to real-time analysis.
- **Proactive Design:** Evidence-based policies targeted at evolving needs.

Goal: To transition from reactive observation to proactive, AI-driven policy design.

Four Strategic Pillars of EU - ALMPO



Policy Innovation

Improving design and monitoring of ALMPs to ensure inclusive, targeted, and evidence-based policies.

Skills Development

Promoting lifelong learning and bridging labor market gaps to support workforce adaptability.

Centralized Observatory

Developing a central hub for data-driven insights using a sophisticated IT platform and AI tools.

Vulnerable Groups


Enhancing employability for disadvantaged groups through tailored interventions and support.







What have we achieved so far? (Month 14)



WP1: Analytical Model & Evaluation Framework

Establishing the theoretical backbone of EU-ALMPO.

- **The Landscape Defined:** Completed comprehensive literature synthesis defining ALMPs and categorizing skill mismatch types.
- **Drivers of Change:** Mapped critical internal and external factors fueling labour market transformations.
- **Evidence of Impact:** Conducted a meta-evaluation to determine ALMP effectiveness across diverse target groups.
- **Core Output:** Delivered the **Analytical Framework (D1.1)** – the project's guiding instrument.
- **Stress-Tested:** Validated the framework through rigorous consultation with **key European stakeholders**.





WP2: Skill Matching Strategies & Ecosystems

Establishing the theoretical backbone of EU-ALMPO.


- **Ecosystem Mapping:** Completed deep-dive mapping of skills ecosystems across five partner countries.
- **Best Practices:** Identified and cataloged scalable practices for regional and sectoral skills-based matching.
- **The Deep Dive:** Delivered **10 National Case Studies (D2.1)** covering diverse market conditions.
- **Community Building:** Establishing active Communities of Practice to foster ongoing stakeholder dialogue.
- **Future-Ready:** Preparing the **Recommendation Report for AI-based matching tools (D2.2)**.

This structure transforms unstructured text into a database capable of answering complex analytical questions about policy effectiveness spanning 1994–2025.



WP3: AI-Powered Repository for ALMPs Knowledge Management

Establishing the AI-enabled tools.

- **Deployment of the AI-Powered Repository:** Successful implementation of the core knowledge base and the 'EUALMPO Dataset' (Deliverable 3.1 completed M10).
- **Taxonomy Creation:** Established a comprehensive ALMP classification framework serving as the single source of truth for metadata extraction.
- **Operational Annotation Pipeline:** Fully functional pipeline handling PDF-to-Markdown conversion, intelligent chunking, and LLM-based metadata extraction.
- **Annotator UI Launch:** Development of a multi-interface system (Viewer, Editor, Web App) allowing researchers to validate extracted policy evidence.
- **Structured Data Generation:** Production of enriched NDJSON storage containing validated 'evidence trails' ready for analysis.




What do we aim to achieve?



- **The Interactive ALMP Design Wizard:** Launch of a user-friendly tool (D3.2) that guides policymakers through the design of interventions using historical success data.
- **RAG System Implementation:** Integration of a Retrieval-Augmented Generation (RAG) system to power semi-automatic annotation and intelligent policy queries.
- **Context-Aware Recommendation Engine:** Development of a system that suggests intervention pathways based on specific economic contexts (e.g., high vs. low unemployment scenarios).
- **Self-Sustainable Ecosystem:** Creation of a machine learning system that continues to learn and improve its accuracy beyond the project lifecycle (2027).



From Raw Data to Policy Design: The Value Chain



Central Data Storage

Establishing a centralized repository for ALMP data.

Annotation Tool

Developing a tool to process and categorize ALMP data.

RAG System

Implementing a system to power intelligence and analysis.

ALMPs Wizard

Creating a wizard to guide ALMP design.

Continuous Enhancement

Ensuring the longevity and effectiveness of ALMPs.


